## Fire Chief's Report:

### Old Business:

- Still trying to get cameras for the training center to keep vandalism and dumping down. There is also an issue with the gate being unlocked.
- Engine 6 sewer complete
- Working on the study for the new central fire house RFQ
- Still checking to see if we can bill for large scale fires which can be costly. Misty Fuller was going to forward the emails that she received from Will to Keith and Jeff.
- Fixing Engine 5-The part is coming in on the 19<sup>th</sup>. Once its installed and passes the third party pump test it will be returned.
- The chiefs are working on a list of vendors for an apparatus sale. They should have a complete list next week.
- It was brought up that Commercial Builds should have a list of local agents/owners to call for any issues. It was suggested that it would go to the Code Committee to add it like the requirement is on multi family units. Another suggestion is to have the numbers in the Knox Box for easy access. The Fire Inspector could assist in this matter.
- Rescue 3 after a recent test drive the engine broke down. When Hockenberrys towed it he suggested it may be a leak in the fuel line. This turned out not to be the case so the vehicle is still being checked out.

### New Business:

- Attached is the February fire call summary
- AFG Grant is done. Now looking to get letters of support from local politicians
- T-Mobile is ready to go live with MDT switching from Verizon. The cards are in and being installed on the tablets. Should be done by the end of the month and Verizon can be canceled
- Bail-out training and recertification is complete.
- The second live burn is set for March 24th
- A CREST grant almost finished for \$55,000 towards a new command SUV. It goes to the next council meeting for approval.
- There are 4 options for new apparatus. It was suggested by Keith that we set up a small group to go over the options and choose the best one.
- Hose, Ladder, and Pump testing will be conducted next month.

### Emergency Management/ Vehicle Maintenance Report:

#### Old Business:

- All the phones in the Fanum building are working except DPW and PD

#### New Business:

- Annual inspections and annual service of fire apparatus is being done.
- Truck 7 still has some issues being checked out.
- Parts for some of the older apparatus is getting hard to come by due to the fleet getting older. We are looking at junk yards and Ebay for a replacement mirror and light bar strobe.
- There still is no news on the Dam Report or Emergency Action Plan
- There will be a live drill in Lake Wallenpaupack in April and Rio Dam Drill will be in May.
- The state reservoirs are at 100 % and the river is higher because they are dumping water from the reservoirs
- There has been no new information on the Aqueduct Project.

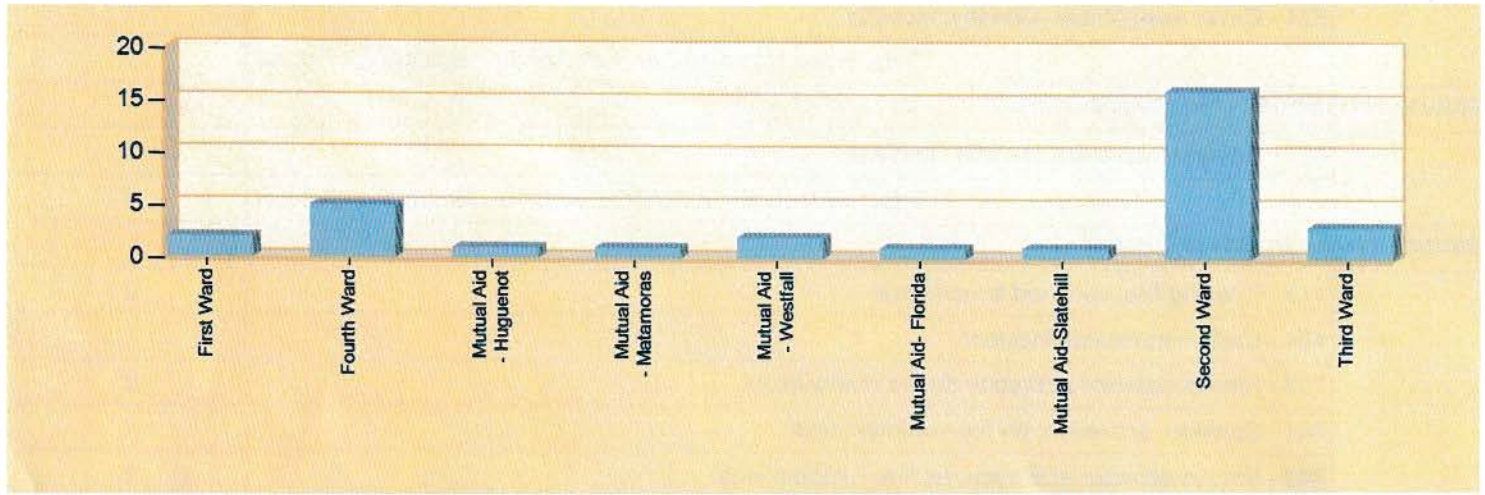
