RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT JERVIS
Community Project Funding Federal Grant

WHEREAS, U.S. Representative Sean Patrick Maloney is accepting applications for Community Project Funding from qualified municipalities such as the City of Port Jervis; and

WHEREAS, the City desires additional funding to meet public needs and provide public benefits, including that of effective technology that will assist in investigating, responding to and preventing crime; and

WHEREAS, if awarded and it is feasible to accept a particular grant, the City will contribute any required local share of costs and/or matching funds necessary to implement the grant project; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Common Council that submitting applications for future available grants is in the best interest of the residents of the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby

RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Port Jervis hereby approves the online submission no later than close of business on Friday, April 15, 2022, to the office of Representative Maloney for consideration of Federal funding for a Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), Technology and Equipment grant under the U.S. Commerce, Justice and Science Subcommittee, Department of Justice, for four street cameras and directly affiliated components totaling some \$68,000.

RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all applications and documentation required by Representative Maloney or his staff to effectuate the intent of this resolution, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Common Council fully supports this initiative and directs Mayor Kelly B. Decker, or his designee, to provide an appropriate letter of support for this submission.
