**A LOCAL LAW OF THE CITY OF PORT JERVIS, COUNTY OF ORANGE,
AMENDING CHAPTER 115, ARTICLE II, SECTION 115-15 OF THE CITY CODE
RELATING TO THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS OF CITY EMPLOYEES**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT JERVIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose

It is increasingly difficult to hire employees for various employment positions in the City of Port Jervis due to the current requirement that with limited exceptions, such employees must reside within fifteen (15) miles of the City limits. The Common Council deems it necessary to expand the geographic radius in which persons must reside to be eligible for City employment.

Section 2.

The City of Port Jervis Code, Chapter 115 entitled Officers and Employees, Article II: Residency Requirements shall be amended by adding the highlighted language to Section 115-15 entitled: Certain proximity to City required:

Employees of the City of Port Jervis, other than those employees specifically set forth in § C2-2 of the Charter of the City of Port Jervis, shall be eligible for employment by the City of Port Jervis provided that they reside within **the County of Orange or 25** miles of said City of Port Jervis as measured from the nearest boundary line of said City. In case such employee, after employment, shall cease to be a resident within the limits hereinbefore set forth, his employment shall thereby be terminated.

Section 3. Separability

If any provision of this local law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this local law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Common Council of the City of Port Jervis hereby declares that it would have passed this local law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

Section 4. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
