**RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT JERVIS
AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO SOLICIT PROPOSALS FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES POLE BARN STRUCTURE FOR
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS**

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is in need of a new pre-fabricated administration building for said Department which shall be a pole barn; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to solicit proposals for aforesaid pole barn to insure that the City selects the lowest responsible bidder in accordance with New York State law,

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE HEREBY

RESOLVED as follows,

1. That the Common Council hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Public Works, or his designee, to solicit bids from interested contractors for the design, purchase and installation of a pre-fabricated administration building for the Public Works Department which shall be a pole barn; and
2. To thereafter report back to the Common Council with the results of said proposal submission.
