Fort Decker, the oldest house in Port Jervis, was built by Martinus Decker in 1793 from the remains of the 1760 fort. This Revolutionary War Heritage Trail site houses tools, artifacts and numerous displays.

The Port Jervis Fire Museum opened in the former Engine Company #1 fire station, Truck 7 in 2007. The museum houses photographs and artifacts from the history of the fire departments, including an 1894 pumper.
