Fire Chief's Report:

Old Business:

- Engine 5 Update The truck has been moved to Long Island and the new engine has been ordered. Expect a 6-8 week return to the city.
- Squad 821 is in service and the old engine 1 has been relocated to engine 5 station in west end while 825 is being repaired.
- Utility 823 is in service, we are awaiting a date from the vendor for it to return for the mounting of equipment brackets.
- Subcommittees
 - Get Better Workgroup
 - No update available awaiting a plan from the city clerk treasurer. Meeting held with vendor regarding financing options.
 - Central Fire Station Workgroup
- Apparatus Maintenance Contract Update Contract has been sent to Corporation Council. Awaiting finalization.

- FIIT Test, Bailout and Live Burn trainings are under way and are slated to be completed by month end.

New Business:

- The Delaware has had its second drowning of the season.
- Structure fire on Kingston Avenue.
- Chiefs attended the water rescue meeting hosted by Kittatinny. All departments from Narrowsburg down were invited but there was limited attendance.
- Parade prep is under way. FD is working with DPW on clean up and repairs.
- FD will be doing firework details in the city on 7/3 and assisting Matamoras on 7/4.

Emergency Management Report:

Old Business:

-Farnum Phones are still not functioning. Tom supplied a list of lines and their functionality which will be typed and forwarded to the city clerk.

New Business:

- June 1st to October the DEP will be releasing water from the Dams. They have no plans to reduce the amount of water released if there is excessive rain/potential flood stages. OEM estimates potentially 1ft increase in the river levels on a sunny day.

Vehicle Maintenance:

- Hook & Ladder is still experiencing load manager issues. May not be repairable and may need to be replaced. Also experiencing DEF issues.
- Engine 6 had a module replaced.
