# PJ Rec Summer Program 2025

### Playground/Camp and Youth Center Schedule

This summer's 6-week program will begin on Monday, June 30<sup>th</sup> and end on Friday, August 8<sup>th</sup>. This summer we are opening Church Street for our outdoor supervised programming. Regular operating hours will be Monday-Friday from 9:00am-3:00pm.

The Youth Center will begin its summer schedule June 30<sup>th</sup> as well. The Youth Center summer hours will be Monday-Friday 9am-4:00pm. The Youth Center summer schedule will run through Friday, August 8<sup>th</sup>.

Beginning Monday, July 7<sup>th</sup>- lunch will also be served daily at both Summer Program sites. This FREE lunch program will run through August 7<sup>th</sup>.

#### West End Beach

The beach is scheduled to open on Thursday, June 26<sup>th</sup>. The beach will be open Monday, Thursday, and Friday 12pm-6pm and weekends 11:00am-6:00pm. The beach is closed on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. The beach is scheduled to close on August 21, 2025.

### West End Beach Bathhouse update

Our DPW staff has done a tremendous job renovating the bathhouse. Work is almost complete, and it will be ready for the beach season which starts on June 26<sup>th</sup>.

### Splash Pad update

Work continues with our new Splash Pad at Church St. Park. Once again, our DPW team has done a fantastic job preparing the site for the splash pad. Most of the underground plumbing is complete and we hope to start installing the actual splash pad very soon. We are still shooting for a July 1 opening.
