Fire Chief's Report:

Old Business:

- Fire Department reports are included for Dec 2025 and for the year 2025. Total calls for Dec were 43 and total for the year was 484.
- Lexipol has about 30 people logged in. We need to get everyone logged in to view policies.
- NERIS is up and running but it is moving slow

New Business:

- The new fire chefs are getting set up in their new roles
- Extractors and dryers were installed in the Decon room
- Tony wants to get training set up on a monthly basis and it to be company wide
- SCBA training for all fire fighters will be held next week
- There will be a meeting on Feb 11, 2026 at 7:30pm at the museum for Engine 2 members to discuss their membership

Emergency Management Report:

Old Business:

- Truck 7 had issues with the DEF but we reset the computer and tire issues were taken care of by DPW
- Engine 6 had an issue with the rear tires valve stem and we had to call the contractor to fix it
- Engine 2 building had an air compressor installed
- Engine 4 fire house generator had some issues with the governor and it was serviced
- Engine 1 in October had damage to the bumper guard and we contacted Campbell and Sparten to get the part
- Ryan submitted the paperwork back in September to get the inspection station set up but no update

NEW BUSINESS:

- Telephone are all hooked up in all the firehouses. There are 2 separate lined in each house
- The reservoirs are at 70% the river is at 2.7 and going to 2.3 by the weekend. This may cause ice to build up
- The 5 year mitigation plan is complete and should be going to the council next

Fire Inspector Report:

- Some inspections are behind but are being caught up
- CO protection is increasing
- Sprinkler inspections has increased
- 100 Pike St has a new alarm company for the gym they are renovating
- 55 Seward Ave will be a new Deli
- KDC is going to install a new chemical container storage
- The Cannabis locations at 110 Jersey Ave is up and running and the one on E Main St will be soon but both had the Knox boxes installed.
- There are new code for food trucks. It will be discussed for the 4th of July event






