### Old Business:

- AFG is Done as of Oct 1st

- E 4 replacement-Now there is a new clerk there will be budget workshops for equipment replacement and funding
- The sale of E1 and R 3 had 2 people interesed. One from Georgia and one from the Chief of Monticello but no further conversations.
- Rover issues-The county is starting to switch over but some calles are not getting thru. It is happening on both Apple and Andriod servcies.

### New Business:

- Keith Brown met with Liz Miller who works for Sen Skoukis. They were talking about the tax issues with the styphen program. Also they dicussed the Safer Grant for the new SUV and getting Military Surplus equipemnt thru the government.
- Grants were submitted for the Safer Grant and the TC Energy Grant

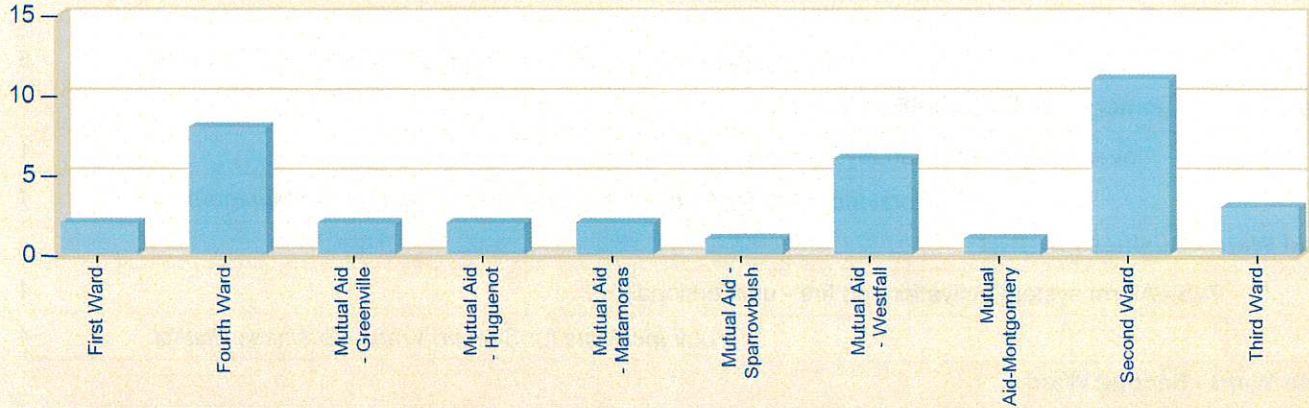
