- Spanish Interpretation Services: The need for a Spanish Interpreter was discussed. Increasing Spanish-speaking population. Required for accreditation. Sarita Cuevas proposed hiring as a contract worker at \$55 per hour. Contract to mirror her contract with Orange County. Fuller mentioned iPad based service used at Bon Secours. O'Connell mentioned difficulties working with language lines. Mr. Vicchiariello stressed the importance of an interpreter who can physically appear for court proceedings. Lt. Sargente stressed the importance of an in-person interpreter for violent crimes and sex crimes where there is a victim, and also for suspect interviews.

- License Plate Reader and Surveillance Camera Project- Lt. Fitzpatrick provided an update of the current city-wide camera project.
