### Meeting Discussion Minutes - Agenda Items

Call to order- Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting was called to order at 6 pm by Mr. Vicchiariello. A quorum of the committee and the following members of the council were present: Mr. Vicchiariello, Mr. O'Connell, Ms. Mann, and Mr. Rhoades.

Public Comment- No Members of the public commented.

### Discussion of Agenda items

#### **New Business**

- Funding Award National Night Out, August 5. Sen. Skoufis has secured \$10,000 in funding to assist with the NNO Celebration.
- ATV Complaint- Lincoln Street The Department is working with the property owner and area residents to address excessive noise from ATVs operating on the property of Big and Little, located adjacent to Canal, Lincoln, and North Orange Streets.
- PERMA Body Armor Grant Application- The department requested \$4,032 in funding to offset the costs of purchasing body armor from PERMA.
- 149 Pike Street- Refuse Collections Mr. Vicchiariello updated the committee on a potential traffic issue that may be caused by commercial refuse collection at 149 Pike Street.
- KDC One has requested that a crosswalk be implemented for employees to cross River Road to access the Michael McCarthy walking path on River Road. DPW, PD, and KDC One have conducted a site visit and are evaluating options to determine a suitable location to install a crosswalk.
- Delaware Bridge Traffic Plan- No Left Turn Discussion- The committee discussed the
  current traffic plan developed for the Delaware River Bridge project and recent motor
  vehicle crashes occurring on the bridge. The committee requested an updated copy of
  the traffic plan for review. The Police Department will assign patrols to monitor traffic
  and address violations as they occur.

#### **Old Business**

• Pike Street Parking Complaint – The committee discussed implementing the following solution to the ongoing dispute regarding a 15-minute parking sign on Pike Street:



Change the sign to 30-minute parking. Add placard limiting parking Tu-Sat 9 am-6 pm. Complaints regarding overlimit parking will be forwarded to the police department. Committee to reevaluate in September.

- Review of Technology Grant The Department is reviewing the budget for the technology grant and will be purchasing mobile data terminals and replacement portable radios.
- Police Recruitment Exam- Test scheduled for September 20<sup>th</sup>. A complimentary physical fitness practice screening test will be hosted for participants to help prepare for the physical agility test.
- The Chief reviewed the budget plan for the SNUG Anti-Violence Prevention Grant for 2025-2026.
- The department is submitting a reimbursement request through DASNY for \$97,399.67 for Phase I construction costs related to the department training building.
